



PRECAUTIONARY BOIL WATER ADVISORY

Effective Date: June 13, 2026

The Village of Bradford has issued a Precautionary Boil Water Advisory for all customers served by the Village water distribution system, effective immediately on June 13, 2026.

This advisory is being issued as a precaution due to conditions that may have allowed contamination to enter the water distribution system. Until further notice, all water used for drinking, cooking, making ice, brushing teeth, washing dishes, and preparing food should be brought to a rolling boil for at least one (1) minute before use. Bottled water may be used as an alternative source of drinking water.

The Village is taking the necessary corrective actions and collecting bacteriological samples from the distribution system. The advisory will remain in effect until the required testing confirms that the water is safe to consume and the Village notifies customers that the advisory has been lifted.

Customers will be informed through official Village communications when the Boil Water Advisory has been rescinded. Do not discontinue boiling water until you have received notification that the advisory has been lifted.
